



Praying Through Sukkot

EIGHT FAMILY PRAYER PROMPTS FOR THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES

These are not prayers you must recite. They are simple starting places to help your family talk with Yehovah together. Read the Scripture, share what is on your hearts, and pray in your own words.

1

Thank Yehovah for Dwelling with His People

Exodus 25:8

Thank Yehovah for choosing to dwell with His people. Ask Him to make your family more aware of His presence throughout Sukkot and every day.

Pray for Your Family to Walk in His Ways

Deuteronomy 6:6-7

Pray for each family member by name. Ask Yehovah to help you love His Word, obey what He teaches, and encourage one another as you walk with Him.

2

Remember His Provision

Deuteronomy 8:2-4

Thank Yehovah for the ways He has cared for your family - including the things you may have overlooked. Ask Him to help you trust Him and share with others.

Remember Yeshua Who Came to Dwell Among Us

John 1:14

Thank Yehovah that Yeshua came near and dwelt among us. Ask Him to help your family follow Yeshua's example and walk as He walked.

3

Trust Yehovah When Things Feel Unfamiliar or Scary

Psalms 56:3-4

Tell Yehovah about anything that feels new, uncertain, strange, or scary. Ask Him to give each person courage and help your family trust Him together.

7

Look Forward to the Coming Kingdom

Revelation 21:3-4

Thank Yehovah for the promise that He will dwell with His people. Pray for those who are hurting, lonely, or afraid, and rejoice in the hope of His coming Kingdom.

4

Welcome His Presence into Your Home

Exodus 33:14

Ask Yehovah to fill your home with His peace. Pray that your words, choices, and treatment of one another will make your home a place that honors Him.

8

Rejoice and Remain Close to Him

John 7:37-38

Thank Yehovah for the joy of Sukkot. Ask Him to keep your family thirsty for His truth and help you carry what you have learned into the days ahead.
